

#### **REVENUE \$133,311**


In addition to raising money each year for charitable projects, the Redondo Beach Rotary Community Foundation is building an endowment fund to continue our good work over time.



#### **EXPENDITURES \$76,752**

Over 94% of all funds raised go directly to projects.

Less than 6% of contributions go to fundraising and operations.

We couldn't have done it without you!


## **Rotarians in Action**

Sponsored students for RYLA, a district wide intensive leadership camp, enabling students to develop leadership skills






Worked with Redondo Beach Union High School selecting the best work from up-and-coming artists and entering their work in a district wide Rotary art competition
